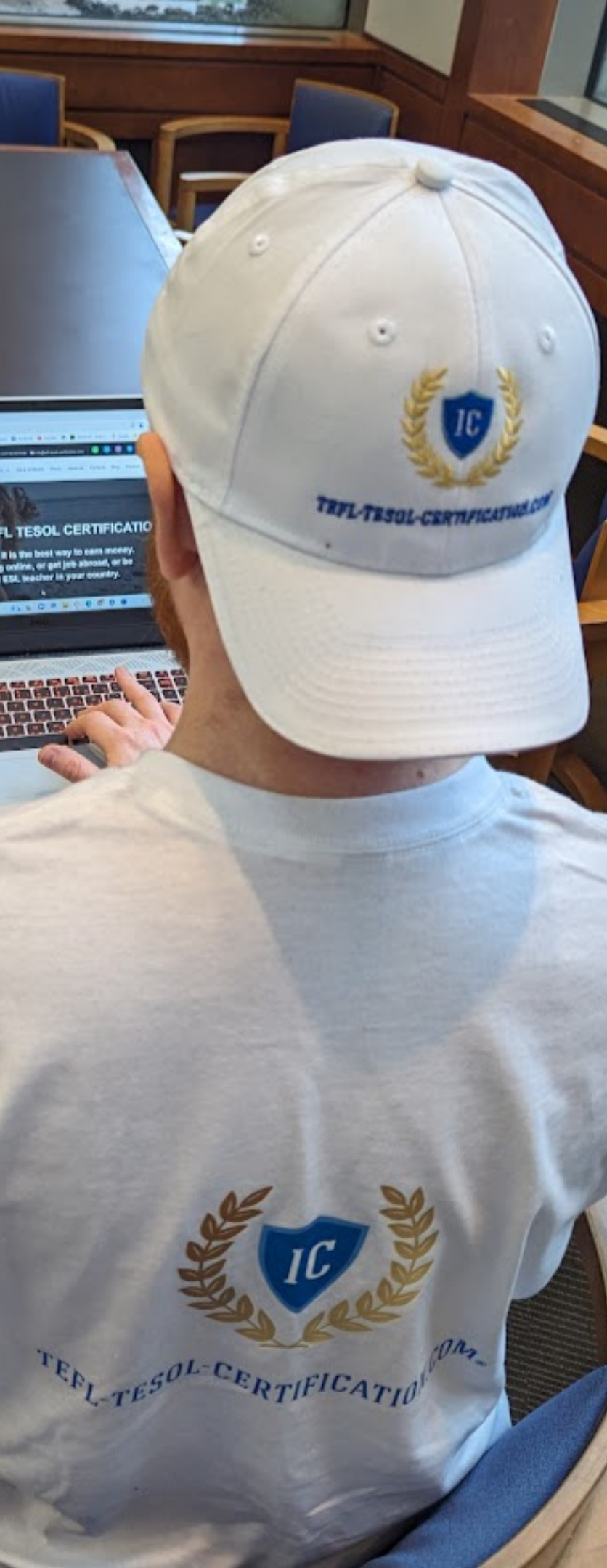

32 North American Companies

[Seer English](#) is a Canadian firm that teaches Chinese students. They are seeking TEFL-certified teachers, bachelor degree holders. The schedules of teachers must be planned out for ten months at a time. There is flexibility in scheduling. The busiest hours are (EST) Mondays to Thursdays: 6:00 a.m.–11 a.m., Fridays: 6:00 a.m.–10 a.m. and 07:00 p.m.–12 p.m., Saturdays: 2:00 a.m.–10 a.m. and 07:00 p.m.–12 p.m., and Sundays: 2:00 a.m.–10 a.m. They pay via PayPal every two weeks, up to \$25 CAD for each 50-minute class.

[Canada UASK Education](#) is an Ottawa-based Canadian firm that teaches Chinese students. They are seeking TEFL certified teachers with one year of classroom experience, a university degree, and experience teaching both French and English. All of the teaching materials are provided by UASK, and their small sessions consist of one to five young students, often in the 4–18 age range. There are full-time positions available. Their hourly pay ranges from \$18 to \$30 CAD.

[Novakid Portal](#) is a San Francisco-based American company. Teachers work one-on-one with students ages 4 to 12. They are seeking native speakers with a university degree and a year of experience working with children, preferably from the USA, UK, Ireland, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, or South Africa. In addition to guaranteeing a minimum of 10 hours each week, they provide flexible scheduling. They pay \$16 USD per hour.

Vnaya [Online Tutoring, Test Preparation & Parenting Support | Vnaya](#) is an American firm (with connections to India). They offer one-on-one online sessions to K-12 students in North America and in the Oceania region in English, Math and Science. Their salary varies from location to location.

Mango Languages [Online Language Learning Software | Mango Languages](#) is an American organization. They offer teaching English, Spanish, French, Russian, Hebrew and other languages (they possess software for 70 languages). They demand that teachers work a minimum of ten hours per week.

[Accent Advisor](#) is an American firm that specializes in teaching the American accent. The students are adult foreign-born residents of the United States who are fluent in English but wish to lessen their foreign accent. Teachers need to have two years of teaching experience and a North American accent. TEFL certification and a university degree are valued assets. The sessions are scheduled according to your schedule, and teachers create their own schedules from 10 to 40 hours each week (from 7 a.m. to midnight EST). Accent Advisor's hourly pay is \$15 USD, with a raise of \$1 for every 500 teaching hours, up to a maximum of \$20 per hour. Teachers receive full payment for student no-shows and for lessons that were cancelled with less than 2 hours' notice. There are no financial penalties for being late, last-minute cancellations, taking time off, technical problems, etc., unlike the majority of other organizations.

[COREnglish](#) is situated in Salt Lake City, USA, and specializes in teaching Chinese students. This firm offers teachers fixed lessons with the same students, which is a huge benefit. Each lesson lasts 25 minutes and ranges in size from 1 to 5 students. Teachers are required to hold a bachelor's degree and be available for work from 6 to 8 a.m. EST, four days a week, for at least two hours a day. (You may also teach at other times.) Having a TEFL/TESOL certificate and prior teaching experience are desirable. It is accessible for non-natives to apply. They pay by PayPal or by wire transfer from \$10 to \$20 USD per hour.

[Fluency Tutors](#) is a Vancouver, Canada-based online training and recruitment company for ESL teachers. They are now employing TESOL-certified teachers. You must have six to twelve months of experience, be certified in TESOL/TEFL/CELTA, and be Canadian. Teachers can create unique online profiles by registering with FT. Fluency Tutors collaborates with ESL programs in the USA, Russia, and China. To determine how much teachers will be paid, they negotiate.

[Teach Kids English Online - Teach Part Time](#) is a recently established company with its headquarters in Toronto, Canada. They only seek native speakers with a bachelor's degree from Canada, the United States, or the United Kingdom to teach children aged 5 to 12. The average teacher works around 20 hours a week, and their hourly wage ranges from \$14 to \$25 USD. Depending on the contract, they may pay every two weeks or every month.

[Native Monks](#) is an American company based in Texas. English, Spanish, Mandarin, Italian, French, German, Japanese, Russian, Hindi, and even Haitian Creole are among the languages they teach. They deliver one-on-one lessons via Skype. Only native speakers are preferred, and teachers are free to choose their own rates. Monthly payments are made on the fifteenth.

[eBerlitz](#) – You've undoubtedly heard of Berlitz if you have experience teaching ESL overseas. This American company maintains offices in more than 70 countries.

[LinguaPlex](#) is an Idaho-based company; and they are now looking for English and Spanish teachers (they teach a variety of other languages). They hire native speakers to teach students one-on-one and to proofread their written assignments. Their area of expertise appears to be in editing and proofreading business reports, resumes, and presentations. They pay around \$5 for editing a page with 250 words, or \$0.02 per word. For lessons, they pay \$18.20 for each 50-minute class, and \$11.20 for each 25-minute class.

[Teach Away](#) – Although it is a big Toronto-based recruiting company, they are now employing teachers directly. 250 teachers are needed to teach K–12 students in China. They recruit everyone with a bachelor's degree, including non-native speakers. While not required, experience and an ESL certificate are appreciated. Candidates can begin teaching in a few weeks after completing a two-step interview procedure and creating a Teach Away profile. The firm provides teachers with materials and training. Peak teaching hours are from 8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. EST every day and from 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. EST, which is ideal for night owls.

Chelsea International Education [Become a Chelsea Tutor - Chelsea International Education](#) is a Florida-based American company. They identify themselves as a premium online and in-person company. They specialize in college admissions, test preparation, and life coaching and work with students of all ages, from kindergarteners to PhD students. They are looking for teachers with a minimum of two years of teaching experience, a college degree, and a teaching certification.

ABC International Group [ABC INTERNATIONAL GROUP INC. Careers and Employment | Indeed.com](#) is seeking native speakers from the US and Canada who have at least one year of experience teaching and a bachelor's degree (an ESL certificate is preferable). The lessons will primarily be one-on-one. They deliver 25-minute lessons to children and 50-minute lessons to adults. Teachers have to work a minimum of 12 hours each week, Monday through Sunday from 5:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. and on Friday and Saturday from 8 p.m. to midnight EST. Pay ranges from \$18 to \$25 USD per hour.

Zamenhof [Teacher Application Form](#) is located in the USA, yet it appears that the majority of its students are from Russia. They are hiring teachers from the UK and North America to work at least 20 hours a week. Teachers with experience are desired. Teachers are free from having to fill out report cards for each class, and they are paid every week via PayPal. Individual lessons cost between \$12 and \$16 USD per hour, specialized English classes cost between \$16 and \$20 USD per hour and group lessons with incentives cost between \$14 and \$16 USD per hour.

[Open English](#) is everywhere on TV, along with some extremely absurd advertisements. It is quite famous across Latin America. They are looking for native speakers with a “North American accent.” Their application states that they are seeking teachers who have permission to work in the United States. The starting pay is about \$10 per hour.

Global Mate New York (GMNY) [Online English Teaching | GMNY&GMK](#) mostly teaches students and professionals from South Korea in the 19–50 age range.

Ginseng English [Ginseng English | Learn English Online | Teach English Online at Ginseng](#) is located in Boston. They recruit the best candidates, so non-native speakers are welcome to apply. Master's degrees are highly valued. They provide both general English and business English in group classes.

Rype [Learn Spanish, French, German, Italian Online | Rype](#) is located in the US and is created for students on the go, so they have an application. They offer multiple languages, and students select their teacher. Their hourly pay ranges from \$9 to \$11.

Voxy [Careers - Voxy](#) is situated in New York and looks for TEFL/TESOL/TESL-certified or degree-holding native speakers. Their hourly wage might reach \$18.

Cambly [English Tutors Online - Cambly](#) is located in San Francisco. They appear to target Korean and Arab students. Students can select their trainers and classes whenever they'd like, thanks to the system they provide. They pay \$10.20 USD per hour, or \$0.17 cents per minute.

Lingo Live [Skills-Based Coaching for Company Success – Lingo Live](#) is an organization based out of New York. They provide language and communication skills coaching to individuals working in the technology industry. The company is seeking remote teachers with a minimum weekly commitment of 15 hours, as they value human capital. It is preferable to attach cover letters along with applications. They teach English, French, Spanish, Mandarin, and some other languages too.

Golden Voice English (GVEOE) [GVE Tutor Portal - Homepage](#) is situated in Toronto, Canada, and teaches English to Chinese students in grades 1 through 9. They have a great variety of curriculum, and they provide both group and one-on-one lessons. They are looking for and actively hiring North American teachers. Their hourly wage is \$20 CAD.

EnglishKey [Online English Learning Solutions for Teachers and Students! | EnglishKey](#) is located in New Hampshire. They are looking for someone who can work in the afternoons and evenings (Eastern Standard Time) for at least ten hours a week. Students are in Latin America; that's why bilingual teachers have an advantage; however, teaching experience is not necessary.

Pearson / GlobalEnglish [Business language and cross-cultural training | Learnship](#) is situated in San Francisco, and their recently updated platform looks fantastic. They provide both group and individual lessons, with a focus on business English. For individual classes, they pay about \$14, and for group classes, \$17.

LOI English [Skype English Classes - Live Classes, Native Speakers - LOI English | LOI English](#) is situated in Montana and necessitates that teachers be available for a minimum of 25 hours per month. They use Skype to conduct lessons, and all of their materials are available online. They are looking for native speakers, particularly South African teachers. After 30 days, the salary increases to \$11 from \$10 initially. They will consider an increased salary for teachers who speak Portuguese and for those who have experience with TOEFL.

Duolingo [Duolingo Careers](#) has been lately searching for language assessment and language teaching specialists. "World-class language experts" is what they seek. To assist with their platform, serving as a kind of consultant rather than a language teacher. They are now searching for curriculum specialists and freelance language teachers with experience in early childhood education.

goFLUENT [Accelerate Language Learning | Business Language Courses](#) is seeking business English teachers to work at least four hours a day, five days a week. They've got a specific time range when they need teachers, so visit their website and check. Additionally, they are looking for native English speakers with some post-secondary education.

EnglishTutorOnline (ETO) [Teacher's Application Form | English Tutor Online](#) employs native English speakers with a university degree who have one year of teaching experience and who live in Canada, the USA, Central America, Asia, or South America. One of the two peak times—mornings, afternoons, or evenings—must be covered by teachers, preferably until 11:00 p.m. or 1:00 a.m. EST. Both adults and children receive one-on-one teaching from them. There is no need for preparatory time, but teachers must be dependable and sign contracts that last at least a year. \$16 USD is paid by ETO each hour.

[Live Lingua](#) is a small American firm that employs less than 20 teachers. They provide a broad range of specialized courses and charge students at least \$20 an hour. Teachers must be bilingual, and they are seeking native speakers with two years of experience and a bachelor's degree.

[SkypeEnglishClassNow](#) is a little US-based company that specializes in one-on-one teaching. Students purchase packages of classes. The price for one class is \$28.99, and for a 15-class package, it is \$299.85, or \$19.99 per class.

ESLstarter [Online Teaching Jobs - ESLstarter](#) is teachers to teach Costa Rican learners. They appear to teach both individuals and groups. They are looking for teachers with a university degree and a TEFL/TESOL certificate. The ideal time for teachers to be available is between 6:00 and 9:30 a.m. EST. They pay a base rate of \$18 for group lessons and up to \$20 USD for each 45-minute class.

Online Teachers UK (OTUK) [#1 British Online School - Speak English With Confidence](#) is a small company based in the UK that targets primarily Russian students. All they want are British teachers. Every lesson lasts 45 or 90 minutes and is taught one-on-one.

Bespoke Language Tuition (BLT!) [French, German, Spanish, 11+ tutors | Bournemouth | bespoke languages tuition](#) teaches English, German, French, and Spanish in addition to exam preparation. It is not known how much they pay, but everyone likes a BLT!

English Skype Classroom [English Skype Classroom - English Skype Classroom - learn English online](#) is a smallish company that offers a wide range of classes, including practice for job interviews as well as exam preparation. They provide in-person or Skype teaching. They only employ native speakers.

7 Spanish Companies

[SkyLearn](#) appears to be located in Spain and teaches both adults and children from all over the world. They are looking for English tutors to teach a range of courses, such as exam preparation and ESL. They are seeking part-time teachers with a university degree and a TESL/TEFL/TESOL certificate, as well as full-time (8 hours a day) teachers. For whatever reason, their salary varies depending on the country in which a teacher resides. They claim to use PayPal to make payments.

Break Into English [Online English Classes Via Skype | Break Into English](#) has more than 100 teachers and 1500 students. They are hiring English teachers to conduct one-on-one lessons with mostly European students. They provide business English classes as well as exam preparation, and they teach both adults and children. Right now, they're expanding into Asia. Their hourly wage ranges from 12 to 14 euros.

[Inglesissimo](#) is a Spanish-based company that provides lessons for individuals and travelers as well as business lessons. There are approximately 900 teachers there. Chinese, German, Italian, Spanish, and French are also taught.

LingoKids [Welcome to Lingokids! The playlearning™ app for kids](#) is located in Madrid. They teach languages to children using their app; they emphasize language immersion through videos, songs, and games in tandem with other offline activities. Teachers deliver one-on-one video lessons with children from all over the world (China, USA, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Mexico, Argentina, Thailand, Malaysia, Philippines and Indonesia). They are looking for teachers who can guarantee ten hours of availability each week during peak hours in Europe. A 15 Mb/s internet connection is required for teachers. You can schedule or cancel classes up to two hours in advance. Applicants have to prepare a 10-minute demo class video on any topic, presented as though it were for a 4-year-old. For every 30-minute class, LingoKids pays \$10.

[Learnlight](#) (previously called ISUS or Ispeakuspeak) is located in Barcelona. Along with teaching English, they also teach fifteen other languages, such as Spanish, French, German, and Italian. Their online platform is modern and well-designed. Mostly, they teach business English to workers of multinational companies located in Europe. It is possible to work part-time; you set your own hours, and they handle finding you students.

[OS Connect](#) is situated in Seville. They have an attractive website (in Spanish), and they have a large selection of courses. They pay between \$7 and \$9 USD per hour for both individual and group lessons. Additionally, they pay for writing corrections, marking, responding to questions on the platform, and creating educational materials.

[EnglishOnlineTV](#) is a Spanish company that focuses on business English and exam preparation. They employ non-native English speakers to teach English. They also teach German, French, and Russian.

10 Other European Companies

LinguaTV [LinguaTV.com - Learn Spanish, French, German or other languages online](#) is a company based in Germany. They provide adult students one-on-one and small-group lessons. Teachers must have a bachelor's degree, a TEFL certificate, and one year of teaching experience; non-native speakers with a C1 English proficiency are allowed to apply.

[Telelangue](#) is located in France. It appears that they teach both English and Spanish. Classes last 15, 30, or 60 minutes, and they teach students all across the world. Only \$9 or \$10 USD per hour is paid there.

Educastream [Formation anglais éligible DIF - Educastream](#) is situated in France and appears to be looking for English teachers. They teach adults, children, and business English. They teach mathematics as well. Teachers are paid an hourly wage ranging from £9.10 to £10.80.

[Novo English](#) is located in France. It appears that they teach children, adolescents, and adults. Teachers are required to be native speakers, and the students select their teachers. The majority of the lessons, which last barely 15 minutes, are conversation classes.

[Fluentify](#) is located in Italy and Britain; they focus on teaching business English. They are looking for teachers with two years of teaching experience as well as online teaching experience and a TEFL certification. They supply some material; however, you may additionally utilize your own teaching materials. Up to 11 euros are paid for each 30-minute lesson.

Learnship [Business language and cross-cultural training | Learnship](#) is located in Germany. They provide group and individual classes. Though they teach in several languages, their area of expertise is business English. Approximately €17 is paid per hour.

FluentBe [Fluentbe.com - Current Openings](#) is a Polish company that is now looking to hire teachers with at least one year of experience teaching adults. Most of the learners are adult Polish citizens. They appear to provide one-on-one and small group sessions for up to four students. They pay about \$10 USD per hour.

Woospeak [English, languages and office automation training center - Woospeak](#) is based in France. An hourly rate of \$16 to \$18 is a proper starting point.

Tandem [Tandem Language Exchange App | Find Conversation Exchange Partners](#) is a recently established German company. They only provide language tutoring via an iOS and Android app, though. This implies that teaching requires the use of a smartphone. Teachers determine their own salary rate. The option for students to find other students and engage in online chatting with them is an additional interesting feature. French, Spanish, Italian, Portuguese, Chinese, Japanese, and Russian are among the languages they teach.

[GoForLanguages](#) is an international organization with offices in the USA, Spain, France, and Belgium. They both teach and do translations. They hire teachers to conduct one-on-one classes that last 30 minutes. Business English is their area of expertise.

30 Asian Companies

[Magic Ears](#) is based in Beijing; they teach young learners aged 5–12. There is a maximum of four students per lesson. They are looking for persons with teaching experience or an ESL/EFL certificate. The company supplies the teaching materials. Weekday hours are 6:30 p.m. to 9 p.m.; weekend and holiday hours are 10 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. to 9 p.m. (Beijing Time). The teacher's effectiveness or the student's inclination toward them determines the booking rate. They provide incentives for punctuality and have 60 available time slots each month, with a base charge of \$9 for each 30-minute lesson. Hence, your hourly wage might be as high as \$22 or even \$26 USD.

[VIPKid](#) is a big, very promising Chinese company. More than 30,000 teachers work there. They only teach children, and teachers have to engage the kids with toys and props. They are looking for degree-holding teachers. There is no minimum number of hours necessary to teach, and scheduling is flexible. They pay from \$14 to \$22 per hour, with bonuses and incentives determining your total salary.

[Qkids](#) is seeking native speakers from the USA or Canada to teach children in China. They were formerly known as 97Kid/Funbulous/JiuQu. Teachers must hold a bachelor's degree or be enrolled in a university program to get one. Teachers are going to teach up to four Chinese kids in 30-minute classes, ages five to twelve. Peak hours in China are weekdays from 6:40 p.m. to 9:10 p.m. and Friday and Saturday from 8:40 p.m. to 11:50 p.m. They pay from \$16 to \$20 USD per hour.

[Education First](#) (English Live / English Town / English First) is a big company that was founded in 1965. They are hiring teachers in the USA or abroad with a bachelor's degree and a TEFL certification. Children from China who attend English classes at one of the EF Kids & Teens English Centers are their students. Since the same teachers will be teaching the same students every week, teachers must make themselves available for a long time. Peak teaching hours in Chinese time are between 5 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. on weekdays and from 9 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. on weekends. The pay starts at \$12 per hour, and \$14 if a teacher is bilingual and speaks Russian or Portuguese.

[Acadsoc](#) teaches a large number of Chinese students. A TEFL/TESOL/CELTA certification are what they require from teachers. They give a basic salary plus bonuses.

[Teacher Record](#) is a brand-new Chinese company that is looking to hire online French and English teachers. They also employ teachers to provide individual lessons in China. They teach grades K–12. Not much is known about the company at this time; however, it appears that they could be a recruiting organization.

[iBestTeacher](#) is a Chinese recruitment organization seeking both native and non-native English speakers to teach Chinese children in the 4–16 age range. You must work at least two days a week for two hours, Monday through Friday from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. Beijing time, and on Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. Depending on qualifications, they pay between \$14 and \$26 USD per hour.

31ABC [Teach Chinese Kids English Online](#) is a Chinese-based company. Chinese children aged 4 to 12 are taught there, with small class sizes of no more than three pupils. Since you will have the same class three times a week, they provide a set schedule. Experienced teachers are what they truly seek. Beijing's peak teaching hours are from 6 to 10 p.m., and they need at least 9 hours each week. In addition to paying a base salary of \$20 USD per hour, 31ABC offers incentives for high performance and teaching a high number of lessons. They can pay using PayPal or a bank transfer.

[Whales English](#) – Sprout 4 Future was their previous name. Parents in China choose the teachers who will work with their children. Children ages 5 to 15 are divided into groups for their lessons. Teachers can choose to teach science, history, literature, writing, and other disciplines in addition to English. They teach French and Spanish, too. Teachers have to be available during busy times. Each 50-minute lesson is paid between \$18 and \$30 USD, and there are performance bonuses available.

[Kaifu English](#) is seeking native speakers from Canada, the United States, Great Britain, Australia, and New Zealand to teach Chinese children in one-on-one lessons, aged three to fifteen. A bachelor's degree, ESL/EFL teaching certification, and previous teaching experience are requirements for teachers. If you lack experience, they will provide training. They appear to expect teachers to commit to a year of teaching, and they have more than a thousand students.

[USKid](#)– they conduct one-on-one classes for Chinese kids. They hire native English speakers who have a university degree and experience. Teachers have to commit to at least 5 hours per week. They pay between \$17 and \$28 USD per hour with bonuses.

[Boxfish](#) is hiring English teachers to use its app to teach Chinese children and adolescents in groups and one-on-one conversational English. They use PayPal and pay \$20 per hour.

BlingABC [BlingABC K12 English Teacher's Portal](#) is seeking English teachers with a year of teaching experience, a bachelor's degree, and a TEFL/TESL certification. All teaching materials are supplied, and they teach Chinese students ranging in age from 3 to 15. Depending on the number of students in the class, they pay between \$21 and \$27 USD per hour, once a month.

[PalFish Teacher](#) is an application and a create-a-profile type company but they just released a course for children. In the create-a-profile version teachers set their own rate, usually between \$10-\$20 USD per hour. Non-native teachers are also welcome to set up a profile. For the children's course, native speakers with experience teaching children and an TEFL certificate are needed. Additionally, they demand that teachers devote at least 10 hours a week between 6 and 9 p.m. Beijing time.

BiteABC [Teacher Recruit](#) is seeking TEFL/TESL certified teachers with a bachelor's degree. They teach students in classes of one to four, ages five to sixteen. PayPal is used to pay teachers between \$8 and \$12 USD for each 30-minute lesson; attendance and quality are also rewarded with incentives. During China's busiest hours, they would like teachers to be available for 7.5 hours per week.

[Teach Future](#) is a recently established company that appears to be a recruiting company. However, they do employ non-native teachers of English. 7 South Korean Companies

[Ringle](#) is a South Korean company with more than a thousand teachers. Additionally, there are jobs for editing and proofreading. They supply the course materials, with no set minimum or maximum work hours, and pay via PayPal either once a week or once a month. Starting pay is \$15 USD per hour, with potential increases to \$25.

[Tutoring](#) seeks teachers with a minimum of two years of teaching experience and a university degree (or enrolled). They target Korean children and adults. Students may learn and attend classes from anywhere by using an app. They use Paypal to make payments. They make three payments a month.

[MentorPhone](#) is a recent arrival to the Korean teaching market. They require teachers to commit to a fixed long-term schedule, Sunday to Thursday from 4 to 10 p.m. EST and/or Monday to Friday from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. Teachers with a university degree, TESL/TEFL/TESOL certification, and teaching experience are the best candidates.

[Learntalk](#) is located in Manila. They offer language teaching to people, organizations, institutions, and other language schools worldwide. Right now, they are focusing on Latin American students. Teachers are free to work as little or as much as they like. The company employs non-native English speakers. Language Tutors, Experienced Instructors, and Professional Teachers are their three distinct teacher categories. Spanish, Italian, French, German, and 46 more languages are among the languages in which their teachers teach. There are several exam preparation programs available, and the majority of classes are taught in English. 25 or 50 minutes are allotted for classes.
